WORKING ON DECK



RECENT EVENTS

- Crew member died after being struck by a rope that snapped back.
- Crew member died after being pulled into the drum whilst guiding nets.
- Crew member was seriously injured after being struck in the head by a steel pole whilst attempting to recover fishing gear.

THINK SAFE

- Are all crew suitably trained for the tasks they are performing?
- Is all gear regularly checked and in good condition?
- Are crew wearing suitable buoyancy aids, especially in exposed areas?
- Are all deck areas clean and tidy?

DO SAFE

- No-one should work alone in dangerous conditions.
- Don't let ropes or lines dangle where they can foul the propeller.
- Unless appropriately trained, crew must not operate winches and cranes.
- Install non-skid gratings in all routine working and potentially slippery areas.
- To prevent formation of kinks and bights, properly coil and stow lines.
